



The Irish Pony Club National Instructors Award 2017

The Irish Pony Club Training Committee is continuing the National Instructors Award honouring Instructors who go above and beyond for those that they teach.

Nominations will come from the branch via the DC to the Area Rep. If more than one nomination is received in the Area, the Area Committee will select one to go forwards to the final. Candidates must be on the current list of the Instructor's Register. Anyone who has been selected for the final cannot be nominated for a further five years. The successful candidates should; through their teaching, instruction and involvement in the branch encourage and foster the ideals and ethos of the Irish Pony Club.

The successful candidates to the final will be invited to an afternoon/evening where they will give a presentation on a topic which they will receive in the post with their invitation. They will be required to deliver their topic presentation to a panel of assessors. They will also be interviewed by the panel or may be required to do a field base presentation. They will be provided with an evening meal to round the day off.

Nominations from the branches must be with the Area Rep on or before 20th October.

Area Reps must submit the area nomination on or before the 27th October to Head Office.
