The Irish Pony Club is a Voluntary Youth Organisation. It is the main equestrian organisation that provides training and competition in Show jumping, Dressage, Eventing, Mounted Games, Combined Training, Hunter Trials, Tetrathlon, other fun activities and stable management for young people. It is affiliated to the Pony Club, the world's largest association of young riders with 110,000 members in 18 countries across the globe. In the Irish Pony Club, we have approximately 3,000 members spread throughout 55 branches across twenty-six counties. The Irish Pony Club is a Voluntary Youth Organisation.

OBJECTIVES

- To encourage young people to ride and to learn to enjoy all kinds of sport connected with horses and riding.
- To provide instruction in riding and horsemanship, and to instil in members the proper care of their animals.
- To promote the highest ideals of sportsmanship, citizenship and loyalty, thereby cultivating strength of character and self-discipline in a safe and fun atmosphere.

MEMBERSHIP

- Open to boys and girls up to 23 years of age.
 - Ordinary members up to 18 years.
 - Associate members are those 18–21 years.
 - Senior Associate members are 21–25 years.
- All standards and levels of experience are welcome.
- Owning your own pony is not a requirement.
- Membership of the IPC is €110 including insurance.

POLICY STATEMENT

- The Irish Pony Club is fully committed to safeguarding the well-being of its members.
- Every individual in the Irish Pony Club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for their own and others' rights, safety and welfare, and conduct themselves in a way that reflects the principles of the Irish Pony Club and the guidelines contained in the Code of Ethics and Good Practice for Children in Sport.
- The Irish Pony Club respects the equality and rights of all its members taking into account their ability and horse/rider partnership.
- It does not discriminate against any individual entrusted to it on the grounds of gender, civil status, family status, age, ability, race, sexual orientation, religious belief or membership of an ethnic community.



BENEFITS

- The overwhelming majority of Ireland's leading national and international riders both past and present started to learn their skills in the Irish Pony Club. They had a lot of FUN and so will you.
- Members will learn to ride safely and correctly while receive riding instruction at rallies which are usually held on land by permission of generous landowners. Other activities take place at riding centres or dedicated venues. Instruction is given in horse/pony care and riding skills.
- Each branch runs a camp which is the highlight of the year for most members, where they spend 4 or 5 days improving their riding skills and horsemanship and having fun.
- As a member of the Irish Pony Club, new horse/pony owners will have the help and support they need to learn new life skills.
- Members can do Pony Club Efficiency Tests which are graded from beginner to advanced and are often a stepping stone to professional qualification to work in the equine industry.
- Members also have the opportunity to collect achievements badges in a range of areas from competition badges like an eventing or dressage badge, equine achievement badges like feeding, handling and grooming to non-equine achievement badges like bird watching and country lore.
- Members have the opportunity to compete in many equestrian disciplines:
 - Show Jumping, Dressage, Eventing, Mounted Games, Hunter Trials, Tetrathlon, Minimus etc.
