



Vaccination Requirements:

- V1 - (initial vaccination)
- V2 - (second vaccination) must be administered 21 - 60 days after V1.
- V3 - (first booster) must be administered within 6 months and 21 days of V2.
- Thereafter subsequent booster vaccinations must be given at intervals of not more than 12-months.
- To stable in certain venues (i.e. Championships) you must be compliant with V1 to V3 and yearly booster.

A horse may not compete if it has been given a relevant injection on any of the seven days before it is to compete at the event.

- All proprietary Influenza vaccines are accepted, provided the route of administration complies with the manufacturer's instructions.
- The Record of Vaccination(s) in the Horse's passport must be completed by the appropriate veterinary surgeon in which the record of injection(s) is completed, signed, and stamped line by line.
- The administration of the vaccine, the batch number, the name, and the date of administration must be recorded on the relevant vaccination page.
- Vaccination must be administered by a veterinarian who must sign and stamp the passport against the relevant vaccination entry.
- Errors in recording vaccination details must be corrected by marking a single line through the incorrect information and re writing all the details for that vaccination on a new line. The veterinarian marking through the incorrect
- *If at any time an injection is given later than is required under these rules, the whole sequence must be started from the beginning.*
